

## UNIFORM GUIDELINES



The complete day uniform is to be worn to and from the college in its entirety. Hat and tie (with only official college badges) must be worn. Skirts are to be worn with the zip completely closed and the length of the skirt must be hemmed at least 5 centimetres below the bottom of the knee.

Socks must be white and they are to be worn pulled up.

During the winter months, students in Years 11 and 12 are required to wear brown tights available from the Retail Centre. Tights are optional for Years 7—10.

School shoes must be polished regularly and be dark brown leather lace-up. Shoes are to be worn correctly with laces fastened. Deck shoes, high heels, Velcro straps and Mary-janes are not acceptable.

The college hat is worn with the college day uniform and it is compulsory to wear the college hat to and from the college. The hat must be worn by students at all times unless a member of staff instructs them to take them off. The hat is a compulsory part of the college uniform and must be with the student at all times. The hat, therefore, must be worn at recess and lunch breaks. The hat must be cleaned on a regular basis.

Blazers are compulsory and if the weather requires it, it is to be worn as the outer garment, to and from the college. Should a student require extra warmth over the day uniform during other months, the blazer is the outer garment worn when travelling to and from the college—not the college jumper. During the period of transition from winter to summer uniform, it is acceptable to students to wear winter uniform without the blazer, although students are not permitted to wear the jumper whilst travelling to and from the college.
