

SSC CMP Private Lessons

Tuition in instrumental and vocal music is offered at San Sisto College. Students can elect to have individual or shared tuition in most instruments.

TUITION IS OFFERED IN THE FOLLOWING INSTRUMENTS/VOICE:

Brass: Trumpet, French Horn, Trombone, Euphonium, Tuba	Upper Strings: Violin, Viola
Woodwind: Flute/Piccolo, Clarinet, Bass Clarinet, Saxophone (Alto, Tenor, and Baritone), Oboe, Bassoon.	Lower Strings: Cello, Double Bass
Percussion: Orchestral Percussion Drum Kit*	Voice
Piano*	Guitar

*Individual lesson only

LESSON FEES

Music fees are issued by account through the individual tutor's business. Fees are charged on a school term basis and are set at the beginning of each year. The relevant musician professional body determines industry fees.

LESSON FEE STRUCTURE

Families may elect their child's lesson to be either:

Individual Private Tuition	30 minutes	\$40.00 per lesson
Group Shared Tuition	30 minutes	\$27.00 per lesson

Tutors will invoice Term 1 fees within the first two weeks of lesson commencement. Fees are due within 14-days of invoice. Failure to pay the lesson invoice by the due date will result in suspension of lessons. The following term's fees will be invoice to families at the end of the previous term where possible.

LESSON PROCEDURES

Lessons are conducted within normal school hours. Any out of class times (before/after school and at breaks) are first offered to Year 11 and 12 students and are up to tutor discretion.

Student lesson times are included on morning notices, Microsoft Teams and lessons times are emailed by tutors. It is the responsibility of each student to check their lesson time.

Missed lessons, without notification, will incur the lesson fee. If your child is sick, you must endeavour to provide notice by 7am to the tutor and CMP

Coordinator via email. The tutor will endeavour to make up missed lessons where notice is provided.

Lessons are organised on a rotating timetable to ensure that students are not missing the same academic lesson each week. Once a student is familiar with their teachers and subjects, they may further discuss with their tutor the best times for their lessons to occur. We have several current music students who manage multiple music lessons each week, during school time, with great success.

PRIVATE LESSON ENROLMENT

To enrol your daughter in private lessons, parents/guardians need to complete and sign the Private Lesson Enrolment form. Multiple lessons can be enrolled for on the one form. This form then needs to be returned to the College by emailing it to the CMP Coordinator, or you may print a hard copy and return it to student reception. Digital copy is preferred. Once it is returned, further information regarding lessons will be emailed to parents and the student can begin lessons. **The enrolment form signs the student to lessons for the entire year, unless written notification (via email to Coordinator and Tutor) is received 2 weeks prior to the end of a school term (before commencement of the next term). Failure to do so will result in that following term's fees being charged.**

HIRE INSTRUMENTS

ENSEMBLES

The college has a variety of small and large ensembles, both open and audition-based, for students to participate in.
