



## Uniform Policy

### Wearing the College Uniform

The students of this college identify themselves in the larger community by wearing their uniforms with pride and respect. The uniform must be kept clean, neat, and in a good state of repair. A student in breach of the college uniform policy will be given a uniform card. Students who receive three uniform cards will enter into a restorative session in order to receive support.

### Day Uniform

The day uniform is the only uniform to be worn to and from the college in its entirety. Hat and tie (with only official college badges) must be worn. Skirts are to be worn with zip completely closed and not rolled at the waist.

### Day Uniform Shoes

School shoes must be polished regularly and be of dark brown colour. Shoes are to be worn correctly with laces fastened and tied in a bow on the outside of the shoe. Deck shoes and high heels are not acceptable. The correct type of school shoe can be purchased from the Rose Retail Centre located at San Sisto College.

### Day Uniform Socks

Socks must be white college socks only, purchased from The Rose Retail Centre at the college and must be worn pulled up.

### Stockings

During the winter months, students in Years 11 and 12 are required to wear brown college stockings available from the Rose Retail Centre.

### Hats

The college hat is worn with the college day uniform, the sports hat is worn with the sports uniform. It is compulsory to wear the college hat to and from the college. Hats must be worn by students at all times unless a member of staff instructs students to take them off. The hat is a compulsory part of the college uniform and must be with the student at all times. Please ensure that hats are clearly named.

## Sports Uniform

Students are not permitted to wear their sports uniform to and from school unless it is a sports carnival day. When students have HPE, they must change into their sports uniform in the break prior to their practical lessons.

## Sport Shoes

Sport shoes must be worn with college sports uniform. It is essential that sports shoes are worn for all HPE and sporting activities. Canvas style shoes are not acceptable.

## Sports Socks

Socks worn for sport must be the San Sisto College sports socks purchased from the Rose Retail Centre at the college. Other socks are not permitted. When wearing the sports socks, the San Sisto printed name must be clearly visible.

## Blazers and Jumpers

Blazers are compulsory and if the weather requires it, must be worn to and from the college by all students during the winter months. Should a student require extra warmth over the day uniform during other months, the blazer must be the outer garment worn when travelling to and from the college – not the college jumper. During the period of transition from winter to summer uniform, it is acceptable for students to wear winter uniform without the blazer, although students are not permitted to wear the jumper whilst travelling to and from the college.

## College Bags

The college school bag and sport bag are compulsory parts of the uniform. A college pull-along school bag is also available as a school bag option. Bags must be clearly named. No additional badging, stickers or graffiti are permitted. The college school bag must be brought to school daily and is stored in the student locker during class time. The college sport bag is required to bring sports gear. It can be used on specified sport days as an alternative to the college bag. Students will be advised when this is permitted. An optional college satchel is available for carrying books to and from classes and is available from the uniform shop. These bags are the only bags permitted at the college.

## Labelling of Items

All items of clothing, equipment, books etc, must be clearly labelled with permanent pen or labels to minimise the accidental loss or misplacement of items. These are expensive items and must be looked after and clearly labelled to prevent accidental loss.

## Earphones/Ear Pods Use

Earphones/Ear Pods are only to be used on the College grounds when directly instructed by the teacher to do so. Jewellery One plain watch and one pair of matching small plain gold or silver studs (with a diameter less than 3mm) or sleepers worn in the lower middle lobe of the ear are acceptable (one sleeper or one stud per lobe). No other jewellery is allowed. Clear plastic plugs, keepers or spacers are not permitted under any circumstances.

## Jewellery

One plain watch and one pair of matching small plain gold or silver studs (with a diameter less than 3mm) or sleepers worn in the lower middle lobe of the ear are acceptable (one sleeper or one stud per lobe). No other jewellery is allowed. Clear plastic plugs, keepers or spacers are not permitted under any circumstances.

## Hair

The student's hair is to be worn neatly and fastened with a chocolate brown band and ribbon or chocolate brown scrunchie if hair reaches the top of the collar. All hair must be firmly tied and pinned off the face and above the collar. Single ponytails or plaits must be held firmly in place beneath the crown. Hair must be obviously combed. Hair is to remain natural in colour and appearance while attending the college. The college permits students to have hair colours that are subtle and natural looking. Our stance is one of moderation. If fine foils or highlights are put in, they must be no more than two shades of variation from the natural colour. Students not abiding by these guidelines must have the colour/cut rectified.

## The following would not be acceptable

- ❖ Extremes of colour contrasting with natural colour
- ❖ Extreme examples of streaking or foiling (in either width or colour)
- ❖ Obvious regrowth of natural colour
- ❖ Extremes in chosen style cut
- ❖ Extremes in use of hair product
- ❖ Extremes in styling of hair

## Chewing Gum

Chewing gum and bubble gum are not permitted while a student is in uniform and/or in the college grounds.

## **Prohibited Beauty Applications**

Nail polish (including French polish) and make-up, including coloured lip gloss, foundation, bronzer and eye make-up, fake or tinted eyelashes/extensions and artificial nails are not be worn while in school uniform. Fake and spray on tans are not appropriate. Tattoos are not permitted.

## **Coloured Bras**

White or flesh-coloured bras are the only acceptable coloured bras to be worn.

## **Deodorant**

Roll on deodorant is the only deodorant permissible at the College.

## **Travelling To and From School**

Students travelling to and from school must show respect for themselves, their college and for others. No student is permitted to leave the school grounds once they have arrived at school regardless of the time. Students are only permitted to leave the school when there is written communication from parents/legal guardians and they are subsequently picked up from the Front Reception by their parent/legal guardian after formally signing out at Student Reception. Students must wear the complete college uniform including the hat, when travelling to and from the college. Students are permitted to transit through shops when catching connecting buses/trains. Students waiting for transport at bus stops, train stations, and transport interchanges are to be in full formal uniform including hat and be mindful of their behaviours at all times. Students are to sit quietly for transport and remember that their behaviour and language must reflect the standard expected of them as a San Sisto College student, as well as those of a member of the travelling public. Students must offer their seats to members of the public and wait until members of the public have boarded a bus or train before doing so themselves. Younger students are to take appropriate directions from senior students when travelling to and from school.
