Strategies for improvement:

- Re-establishing connections with the wider Dominican community and charism.

Success measures:

- Increased percentage of staff completing formation program.
- Increase in engagement opportunities with Dominican community and alumni.
- Qualitative improvement in staff knowledge and engagement with charism.

Learning and teaching

Goal: Curriculum-specific thinking skills embedded in staff pedagogical practice and student dispositions in all Learning Areas

Strategies for improvement:

- Focused professional learning for Middle Leaders in leading teaching for thinking pedagogical practices.
- Embedding teaching for thinking in staff performance development framework.
- Implementation of common curriculum planning framework to embed curriculum-specific thinking skills.

Success measures:

- Improvement in student voice data (qualitative).
- Quantitative improvement in NAPLAN, ACER, SRS, Monitoring tool data.

Wellbeing

Goal: Deepen staff capacity to promote the improvement of relational outcomes by implementation of Positive Behaviour for Learning (PB4L)

Strategies for improvement:

- Staff professional learning in functional behavioural analysis
- Development of school PB4L matrix.
- Student voice prioritised as key data strategy.

Success measures -

- Improvement in the fidelity of staff use of the Engage system (both behaviour and teaching responses).
- Measurable improvement in staff implementation of Tier 1 PB4L support structures in the classroom.

Community Engagement

Goal: More fully engage the school and broader community in the life and culture of San Sisto College

Strategies for improvement –

- Parental survey of engagement opportunities
- Improvement of parent/caregiver information evenings
- Further development of opportunities for parent/community social engagement
- Improvement and diversification of marketing of the College across multiple platforms (*print media, primary school media, social media, display/billboards*).
- Building stronger links with the College alumni
